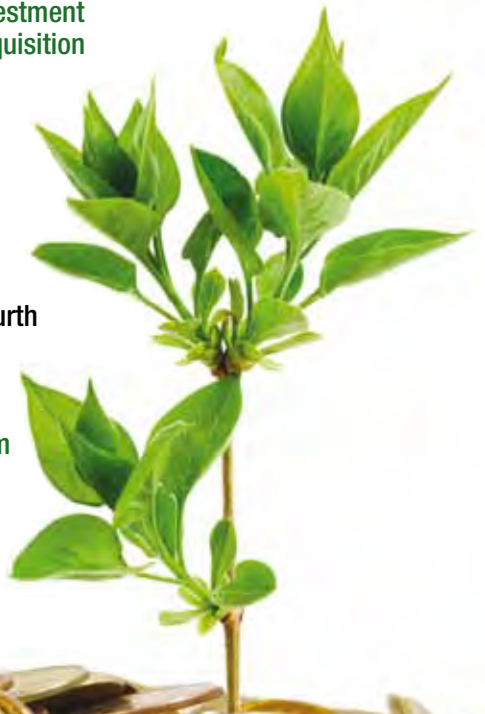
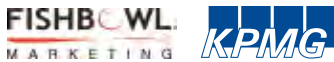
Content overview:
